



GENERAL CONDITIONS

A – OBJECT

This document lays down the conditions to participate to the “Journées Françaises de Radiologie”. Each Exhibitor receives it to apply for admission. Any application implies full acceptance by the Exhibitor, of these General Conditions.

The Exhibitor must conform to these General Conditions and to the Fire Safety Instructions.

The contractual documents are as follows:

- The present General Conditions concerning the “Journées Françaises de Radiologie”.
- The Fire Safety Instructions of the Palais des Congrès de Paris (available on www.jfrexpo.com or www.viparis.com)
- The Reservation Form
- Technical Rules and Regulations of the Exhibition

In case of a contradiction between various documents, these General Conditions prevail.

Only the contractual documents in French have legal value.

B – ORGANIZATION – GENERAL MANAGEMENT

The “Journées Françaises de Radiologie” (abbreviated below as “JFR”) are organized by the Société Française de Radiologie (French Radiology Society, hereinafter “SFR”) who is represented by BGV DÉVELOPPEMENT company (hereinafter “BGV”). BGV DÉVELOPPEMENT is a limited liability company with a capital of 9,146.94 Euros, whose registered office is located at 5, rue de Logelbach 75017 PARIS.

C - DATES AND TIMES OF THE TECHNICAL EXHIBITION

The “Journées Françaises de Radiologie” will be held from 21th to 25th October 2011 at the Palais des Congrès de Paris. The detailed schedule is defined in the section “Schedule 2011” of the Exhibitor Guide.

D – ACCESS TO THE EXHIBITION HALLS

A badge is required to have access to the exhibit halls.

1. Stand installation and dismantling phase

Any person working for the Exhibitor, including in that event the subcontractors and the installers must have a visible badge identifying the Exhibitor. This badge is established by the Exhibitor itself.

2. During the exhibition and the congress

Nobody may enter in the congress or exhibition area, during the entire period of the “Journées Françaises de Radiologie”, without being identified by one of the badges listed below.

All badges issued for the “Journées Françaises de Radiologie” are specified with a name, personal, and must be easy to see.

There are five different types of badges for the «JOURNÉES FRANÇAISES DE RADIOLOGIE»:

Exhibitor Badge “Blue” only for exhibitor staff

Congress Badge “Red”, the SFR membership card serves as a delegate badge

Visitor Badge “Green”

Organizer Badge “White”

Providers of the organization “Yellow”

If the Exhibitor wants to invite someone, the guest must complete a registration form and the exhibitor makes the corresponding payment to the Société Française de Radiologie.

We remind you that the exhibitor's badge is strictly reserved to your collaborators or assimilates working on your stand.

The exhibitor badge cannot be used, in any case, as an invitation.

Exhibitors order badges online, the full application for ordering exhibitors badges and conditions of supply will be specified on exhibitor website.

E - ADMISSION AND MODIFICATION OF THE ADMISSION CONDITIONS

1. Any application to take part to the Technical Exhibition must be sent to BGV DEVELOPPEMENT, by using a Reservation Form duly signed by one of the Exhibitor's authorized staff and not containing any reserves or modifications, accompanied by the down payment required by the Organizer, pursuant to the article F below. Any application containing conditions or reserves will be disregarded.

The application of the Exhibitor will be accepted once BGV has provided to the Exhibitor a confirmation of the availability of the requested location. Requests for specific locations will be taken considered as far as possible.



BGV is entitled to consider and make decisions on an Exhibitor's admission application. Rejection of an application may not, in any case, give rise to damage and interest.

In any case, requests will be accepted in the limit of the available places. Only one Exhibitor will be accommodated in a given space (defined as a floor surface area rented to an Exhibitor by BGV for the entire duration of the event).

2. Once the Exhibitor admission application has been accepted, the contract between the Exhibitor and BGV is definitively formed and can be modified only under the following conditions:

If the Exhibitor wishes a modification of the services he has requested from the Organizer (modification of the area, of the space, of its fittings, of the list of equipments and products accepted by the Organizer...), the Exhibitor must inform BGV of its request by registered letter with receipt.

BGV will have to inform the Exhibitor of its position on the modification request within eight days starting with the date of receipt of the above-mentioned letter. BGV will not be required to accept the request or modification. It will particularly consider the importance of the requested modification and the time remaining before the start of the "Journées Françaises de Radiologie".

If BGV rejects the request, the contract will be performed in accordance with its initial conditions.

F – PAYMENT CONDITIONS

The participation expenses have to be paid in two installments.

The Exhibitor is to pay the first installment of 50% of the total amount including all taxes by check or bank transfer when sending the Reservation Form to BGV.

BGV will send the invoice corresponding to the reservation in return, within a maximum period of 1 month following the confirmation of the admission of the Exhibitor.

The balance will be paid by the Exhibitor by check or bank transfer before **15th August** of the year.

If the balance is not paid within the indicated period, lateness penalties equal to twice (2) the legal interest rate will be applied to the said amount, automatically and without any advance warning being necessary. Moreover, BGV will be entitled to cancel the contract and to reassign the space as provided for in article I below.

Pursuant to article 259 of the General Taxation Code, VAT on the amount of participation expenses is due from all Exhibitors without any exception, whatever their nationality may be, when it corresponds to the provision of services on French territory.

VAT reimbursement may be requested from the approved entities by the Exhibitors themselves, within the limits of the rules and regulations in effect. BGV cannot be asked, in any case, to take such steps.

G – BGV OBLIGATIONS

1. The Organizer undertakes to provide the Exhibitor with a space on one of the two levels of exhibition halls for the entire duration of the "Journées Françaises de Radiologie".

In particular, the stand will include all fittings requested by the Exhibitor and accepted by the Organizer.

2. BGV will supply each Exhibitor with a set of badges enabling its collaborators to enter the Exhibition.

3. BGV commits to include the Exhibitor in the Technical Exhibition Catalogue. The information concerning the Exhibitor will have to be sent before 5th September at the latest.

H – EXHIBITOR'S OBLIGATIONS

1. The Exhibitor undertakes to pay the participation expenses defined in article F of the present document.

2. The Exhibitor may not transfer the space assigned to it or sublet it to a third party, with or without a consideration, without the Organizer's advance and written approval.

3. The Exhibitor is required to occupy its stand for the entire duration of the Technical Exhibition.

4. All stands will have to be entirely dismantled and vacated at 3am according to the schedule provided by the BGV. A "forgotten" stand will be systematically destroyed and the Exhibitor will be charged for the resulting expenses.



5. The structures of the stand and others wastes must be evacuated by the Exhibitor. Any failure to this obligation will be systematically invoiced to the Exhibitor.

6. The Exhibitor undertakes to respect the usual rules of proper behavior.

7. Materials, signs, promotional supports and products which are not corresponding to the theme of the Technical Exhibition are prohibited without BGV advance and written approval. The Exhibitor must respect the limits of its stand.

8. The Exhibitor is liable for any damage caused to the rented space or to the building by itself or by a company intervening on its behalf in connection with transport, installation, operation or removal of its equipment. The rented space must be restored to its initial condition. The expenses for repairing damage caused by the Exhibitor will be entirely for its account.

9. The Exhibitor undertakes to respect the requirements laid down in the present document and the contractual elements defined in article A of the present document, and to have its employees and subcontractors respect them.

I – CANCELLATION OF THE CONTRACT

In addition to the judicial cancellation provided for under article 1184 of the Civil Code, the contract may be cancelled under the following circumstances:

1. Withdrawal of the Exhibitor

In case of withdrawal, the Exhibitor must pay all of the participation expenses, whatever use BGV may subsequently make of the released space.

2. Cancellation of the contract by BGV in case of non-payment of the participation expenses.

BGV will be entitled to cancel the contract between it and the Exhibitor and to dispose of the space initially assigned to the Exhibitor if the latter does not pay the participation expenses within the periods laid down in article F.

If this occurs, the Exhibitor shall have to pay all of the participation expenses as a penalty.

3. Cancellation of the event

In case of major force or of any other unpredictable event for which the Organizer is not responsible and making it impossible to hold the JOURNEES FRANCAISES DE RADIOLOGIE. on the scheduled dates and places, BGV will be entitled to cancel the event, subject to dividing the amounts received as participation expenses on a pro rata basis among the Exhibitors, after deduction of the expenses already incurred for organizing the event.

J – WAIVER OF RECOURSE

The Exhibitor waives any recourse, including third party notice, that it might be entitled to file against the Organizer, the owner of the site and/or the operating company of the site, as well as their insurers, in connection with any material and immaterial damages, consequential and non-consequential, suffered by the Exhibitors (particularly damage to the property exhibited) and their employees, and for which the Organizer, the site owner and/or the operating company is responsible, whatever the cause thereof may be.

The Exhibitor undertakes to bring this provision to the attention of its insurers and to obtain an identical waiver of recourse from them.

K – INSURANCE

Civil Liability Insurance of the Organizer

BGV takes out an Organizer Civil Liability Insurance that covers all damages, including bodily, material and immaterial injury, caused by himself, his staff or his installation.

Civil Liability Insurance of the Exhibitor

BGV is not liable for damage that the Exhibitors might cause to third parties.

Insurance covering damage to property displayed on the exhibition stand

BGV is not liable for the material damage caused to the property exhibited and it is up to each Exhibitor to take out insurance covering such damage.

The Exhibitor may take out such insurance directly with its own insurer.



L – SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor must conform to the safety rules and regulations lay down by the public authorities, by the Palais des Congrès de Paris and by BGV DEVELOPPEMENT.

M - CATALOGUE, DOCUMENTS, ANIMATION, ADVERTISING AND EXHIBITION FILE

Only the JFR' organizer is entitled to publish and distribute the catalogue and any other documents relative to the exhibition. The published information concerning the Exhibitor is the latter's responsibility. BGV may not be held liable in any case for omissions or for errors in reproduction and composition that might occur.

The texts received after the deadlines will not be published.

The data concerning the attendees and the visitors to the Technical Exhibition remain the Organizer's sole property.

Any use of the logotype, the name or any other symbol designating "Journées Françaises de Radiologie" will have to be the object of a request submitted to the BGV.

All advertisements, animations, distribution of documents are forbidden outside the stands. No signs, advertising, documentation or other items may be placed outside the space reserved for the Exhibitor.

N – ELECTION OF DOMICILE

For the entire duration of the "Journées Françaises de Radiologie", including the installation and dismantling periods, the Exhibitor elects domicile at the space assigned to him at the Technical Exhibition.

O - APPLICABLE LAW AND ASSIGNMENT OF JURISDICTION

The present General Conditions are governed by the French law in effect on the date of the event.

In case of a dispute concerning constraint, validity or performance of the present General Conditions, the Courts of Paris shall hold sole jurisdiction.
